Target audience: Consultant level. **Senior** middle-grade doctors/ECPs may attend if **nominated in advance to accompany a consultant** and confirmed by **EMCEF**. West Midlands Region senior trainees may attend instead of going to regional training, but this still requires nomination by a consultant who will accompany. **In all cases, nominations must be registered by the nominating consultant via the website. This cannot be done by the nominee!**

Cost: **£55** discounted early registration fee per consultant for payments made a week or more in advance. **The fee reverts to the full price of £80 for payments received after that time and to £110 for anyone attending without a pre-confirmed place!** Payment instructions are on the penultimate page of this brochure. Nominated colleagues attend **free of charge**, so long as a place is **confirmed in advance**. **Otherwise, they will be charged as above!**

Registration is **free** to non-GMC specialists based outside the UK

In case of a “no shows”, unless cancelled in advance, the full price becomes due. This applies to everyone, including those nominated for a free place. It is the responsibility of the nominating consultant to inform the nominee of this.

Cancellation: Via e-mail or through the website contact form, at least a week in advance. Any fees paid may be applied to a later event
